1970 PROGRAM

Changes and improvements were outlined by Clifford Hanson and Sandy Bridges. New procedures and program were explained by Hanson. Bridges told of the new trail foods, especially meats. It was pointed out that any year now, we may not be able to receive Government Surplus Commodities and this could add up to 25% more to our food costs.

1971 FEES

Robert Banks led the discussion on the present fee of \$475.00 per crew (\$47.50 per person). Approximately \$89.00 per crew is now paid to Canada for Food Tax, Canoe Entrance Fee, Camping Permits, Fishing Licenses, and Guide Licenses. Food costs, equipment and salaries are all on a rapid rise. Also the possibility of loss of surplus commodities point out the need for a higher fee. It was moved by John Budd that Chairman Robert D. Banks, Region Ten Executive and Base Director be authorized to set fees to \$550.00 (\$55.00 per person). Seconded by Kenneth G. Pringle. Carried.

LESS CHANCE BOYS of Region Ten should be encouraged to participate on the Canoe Trails on "scholarships", stated Robert Banks. Crews should be encouraged to bring boys on their own scholarships or/and help provided by local and regional Scouters in Region Ten.

This program is to be announced at the Region Ten Annual Meeting. Cards with information and signup to help these boys to be prepared and given to the men at the meeting. These men should be encouraged to turn in the signed cards at the meeting. Full approval was given by the Committee.

REGIONAL ANNUAL MEETING

The next meeting of the Region Ten Canoe Base Camping Committee will be held at the Region Ten Annual Meeting on Saturday morning after the Regional business meeting at 9:45 am. The Camp Improvement Committee will meet on Friday. Kenneth Pringle will contact the committee to set the time.
