Mr. Ludlow at the canoe base has my application sheet for the bronze paddle award. He said that he would send it in to you when he had signed it and forme to send my log and photographs into you. My log follows:

- Sun. Aug. 2 Wilderness Canoe Base 8:30 p.m. Our group, containing six boys and a guide, in 3 canoes, was the only one to leave Sunday evening. We stopped and camped for the night at 10:30 on the shores of Newfound Lake. We pitched our two tent immediately on landing, four of us sleeping in one and three in the other.
- Mon. Aug. 3 Camp-site on Newfound Weather was windy. We hit a bad headwind on Baylay Bay and our canoe was separated from the others by the wind and whitecaps. We shipped some water but reached the others at the CANADIEN RANGER STATION. We ate dinner and received our travel permits here also. In the afternoon I saw 4 deer. During the day we crossed 4 portages and a lift-over. Camped for night on an island in North Bay
- Tues. Aug. 4 Camp-site in North Bay Weather was clear and sunny. We passed some Chicago Scouts on a two week trip. Passed a porcupine and a muskrat. Went swimming twice. Had lunch at Noon Lake. Camped for night on an island in Northern Agnes. Crossed 9 portages and a lift-over.
- Wed. Aug. 5 Camp-site in No. Agnes Weather was rainy but cleared up later. Paddled down Agnes to Louisa Falls and camped there all day. Porcupine treed in camp all day. Fished but no luck.
- Thurs. Aug. 6 Camp-site at Louisa Falls Weather cloudy and threatening. Stayed here all day. Fished again but no luck yet. Rigged a sail up on canoe and went sailing. I baked two pies and two pieces of flat bread. Carved a totem pole and sang songs around the camp fire. Took baths at Natural tub.
- Fri Aug. 7 Camp-site at Louisa Falls Weather nice Started home. Swede caught a 5 lb. bass and a 3 1/2 lb. Northern. PeeWee also caught a Northern. Crossed 4 portages. Bought candy at trading post. Saw Ranger's plane at Prairie Portage. Passed another group going out. Camped and went swimming on an island in Newfound. Man gave us four fish. Baked another pie.
- Sat. Aug. 8 Completed trip when we reached base at 11:30 a. m. Had lunch and left base at 1:30. Trip Completed.
