July 16

Were issued paddles and canoes and shoved off at about eight thirty (8:30 AM). Paddled from Moose Lake through Newfoundland into Sucker Lake. At the upper end of Sucker we ran into a strong headwind so stopped and ate dinner before crossing Prairie Portage. After crossing Prairie Portage we ran into high winds and made our way to an island at the East end of Baylay Bay where we waited for the waves to quiet down. John O'Brien of Kinross split his heel open on a rock and the guide took him back to the base where he was sent home. The swamper prepared supper (Mulligan stew) and we slept there the first night.

July 17

We had breakfast (corned cereal) and paddled to the ranger cabin in Baylay Bay for our permits. We crossed the portage from Baylay Bay into Burke Lake then another portage into Sunday Lake.

where we camped about ten o'clock (10:00 AM) to wait for our guide. We ate dinner (jam sandwiches) and fished until our guide arrived at about three o'clock (3:00 PM). We ate supper there (beans, rice, fish) and camped for the night.

July 18

We ate breakfast (cornmeal mush) and paddled to the portage from Sunday into Lake Mead ~~which~~ which we crossed ^{then portaged in Lake Mead} and ate our dinner and campsite near Louisa Falls. The guide decided to camp there the rest of this day and all of the next. We split up and went exploring our canoe portaging into Lake Lewis. We returned ate supper and went to bed.

July 19

We ate our breakfast (pancakes) and set out to explore the lower part of Lake Lewis. We also swam, fished, and loafed. After dinner

(meat sandwiches) it started to rain but cleared up later in the afternoon. For supper we had stew after which we had a council fire and went to bed.

July 20

We ate our breakfast (cooked cereal and ^{fruit} ~~apples~~) and portaged back into Madawaska Lake, ^{then into Sunday} and from Sunday into Baylay Bay where we ate our dinner (Jams, cheese, meat, and peanut butter sandwiches). We then crossed Prairie Portage into Duck Lake, paddled through Newfoundland and camped on an island across from our base in Moose Lake. After supper we had canoe tilts and races. We went to bed early that night.

July 21

We ate our breakfast after which we had canoe tilts. At about ten thirty (10:30 AM) we crossed over to our base where we checked in

our equipment and ate dinner. A seaplane came
and took one of the boys home. The rest left at
about one thirty (1:30 PM).

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
