Made camp on an island in
North Bay. And cleaned up a
dirty camp.

Friday -
Broke camp in the morning.
Came to a trading post and
bought some things. Traveled
all day and made 17 miles
and two portages. Made camp
by island near base camp.

Saturday -
Broke camp in the morning
and checked in our equipment
and bid the guides good-bye. Started
for our home at noon.

Monday-

Left base camp about 9 o'clock
A.M. Stopped at a ranger's
cabin on Basswood Lake, and
caught six Canadian geese
skins. Made five portages
and traveled 13 miles today.
Camped by Louisa Falls.

Tuesday-

Fished in the morning and
broke camp at noon. Traveled
ten miles today. Made camp
on an island on Agnes Lake.

Wednesday-

Fished in the morning and had
a good catch. Broke camp at noon.
Made four portages and traveled
14 miles. Made camp on Slade
Lake.
